No previous experience in arthroscopy or MIS fracture repair is needed.

Program Description: Fellow candidate will have a heavy caseload of arthroscopic and minimally-invasive fracture repair. The majority of cases are MIS but the candidate will also perform non-MIS orthopedic cases. The program requires 2 years of training. The typical work week is 5 days. Emergency surgery is not typically performed and after-hours call is minimal. There would be ample time to complete your publication, participate in didactic and clinical rounds, journal club and you would be expected to give one national lecture each year. You would receive an annual salary of \$125,000 for your fellowship. You would receive health care benefits, CE benefits, and 2 weeks annual vacation as part of your package. You would also receive a production bonus of your total revenue including all your primary cases whether MIS or non-MIS. The candidate would also have the opportunity to work as a CE instructor at our CE facilities in Park City, Baltimore and Houston (nexus.vet) and receive supplemental income.
