- Failure to submit progress reports on time will make the principal investigator or, in the case of the Surgery Resident Research Grant, both the Diplomate and the resident, ineligible to submit grant proposals for five years.
- In the event the Research Committee chair deems a progress report to be unacceptable or three years have lapsed without the project reaching completion, the Research Committee will review the progress report and vote to impose a five-year ban from funding.
